Day 1: Vancouver Island - Butchart Garden - Chinatown - Inner Harbor - University of Victoria - Mount Tolmie Park

- The Vancouver Island region is a large, sparsely populated area, encompassing Vancouver Island, the Gulf Islands, as well as a portion of the mainland. It has one of the world's most diverse ecosystems: Rainforests, marshes, meadows, beaches, mountains, oceans, rivers and lakes create habitats for multitudes of wildlife species. In fact, the region is one of the world's premier locations for whale watching, birding, as well as salmon and trout fishing.
- The Butchart Gardens put on a sensational floral show year-round, in some of the most magnificent landscaped gardens on the planet. Gardeners and lovers of beauty alike will be inspired and enchanted by these gardens, first established in 1904. Covering 22 hectares (55 acres), make your way through different garden 'rooms', from the dramatic sunken garden to rose-covered walkways, springtime bulbs, the summertime dahlia walk, amazing fall colors and the Japanese-inspired winter garden.
- The oldest Chinatown in Canada, Victoria's Chinatown had its beginnings in the mid-nineteenth century in the mass influx of miners from California to what is now British Columbia in 1858. It remains an active place and continues to be popular with residents and visitors, many of whom are Chinese-Canadians. Victoria's Chinatown is now surrounded by cultural, entertainment venues as well as being a venue itself.
- Victoria's Inner Harbor is bustling with activity. Here, you can find beautiful handmade goods, unique gifts, Coast Salish art and carvings, portrait artists, jugglers and buskers, food trucks, and so much more. You can choose to travel the area on foot or by carriage (optional) or enjoy an afternoon tea at the famous Fairmont Empress hotel (optional).
- Close to the City of Victoria, Mount Tolmie Park offers views of Victoria and the surrounding areas.
- Mile "0" - the marker is the start of the over 8,000 km Trans-Canada Highway that spans the entire length of Canada.
- University of Victoria - Canada's most extraordinary environment for discovery and innovation and globally recognized research-intensive university.

Day 2: Victoria - Hartley Castle - Gold Stream - Duncan - Chemainus - Nanaimo - Vancouver

- Hatley Castle, a Classified Federal Heritage Building. Since 1995, the mansion and estate have been used for the public Royal Roads University. From the 1940s to 1995, it was used for the Royal Roads Military College, a naval training facility.
- Gold Stream - the park protects a number of red and blue listed species of flora and fauna, including rare wildflowers and plant species such as the Dense Spike Primrose and the Pacific Waterleaf. It also protects various reptiles and amphibians and plays major role in conserving the Goldstream River salmon run.
- Dubbed the "City of Totems," Duncan has more than 80 First Nations carvings located throughout town, and is also home to the Quw'utsun' Cultural Centre.
- Chemainus is a charming Cowichan Valley town located in the Vancouver Island region. Chemainus is noted for its creative community, but its artistic flair is most evident in the 40 plus vivid murals scattered around town that depict its culture and history.
